Forest School Diary 18th July 2025

The children in EYFS enjoyed their session exploring the surroundings of the woodland, seeking out snails and various other bugs they could find lurking in the undergrowth. Balancing skills were also put to the test as the children navigated their way across the tight rope challenge.



Year 1 were not afraid to get their hands dirty this week while they made some great mud faces that decorated trees in the woodland. They used a range of natural resources from around the woodland to give each one a fantastically unique look!



Year 2 got stuck into weeding out their vegetable patch, clearing out all the unwanted weeds before we break for the summer. In between activities the children spent most of their time playing host to the influx of ladybirds that have been swarming the woodlands recently due to the warm conditions.



Year 3 were lucky enough to spot a dragonfly in our woodlands this week, this was in between cooking and munching on nettle crisps and of course, catching spiders.



Year 4 enjoyed cooking nettle crisps this week, they chose to season them with salt, vinegar, chilli and cumin, and really enjoyed them. Many of the children came back for seconds!



Year 5 finished their Forest School year by making a commemorative tile with the impression of a ginkgo leaf pressed gently into the clay. They will be fired and ready to go home next term. Next up was a little plant identification. We learned the difference between gymnosperms, angiosperms, ferns, mosses and liverworts. We were lucky enough to find examples of all these types of plants in our woodland and were able to explain the features that classified them. We also had time for some pond dipping and to study the creatures that have been recorded in our woodland pond over time. It was a lovely way to end our Year 5 Forest School adventure - now bring on PGL and all that Year 6 has to offer!



Year 6 also took part in their very last Forest School session here at Kendall. Enjoying some of their favourite activities such as making nettle crisps over the fire, playing on the rope swing and crafting jewellery. The Forest School team would like to wish the children all the very best for the future.



No waterproof? No Forest School!

To ensure all children can safely and fully take part in Forest School, they must come dressed appropriately, including a **waterproof coat**. We would like to remind you of the importance of bringing waterproofs. Even on sunny days, children often engage in water play, and sudden downpours are common. **Children without a waterproof coat will not be able to attend Forest School**, as staff cannot return them to class mid-session. Schedule of Trips and Visits 2024/2025

Budgeting £20 a quarter (£80 a year – or approximately £2 a term-time week) should cover the cost of trips. Where a trip is more expensive, for example £40, we will always try to make sure that over the academic year, the cost for all 4 Quarters comes to no more than £80 for the trips and visits we organise. Sadly, with school funding being at an all-time low in real terms, the school is financially unable to subsidise trips and visits to the extent it has done in the past. If we do not receive enough contributions to cover the cost, we will reluctantly have to cancel trips or visitors to the school. 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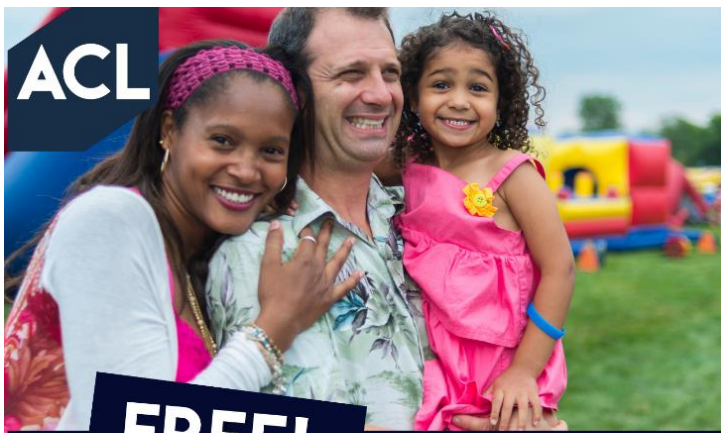

Has your child had all their childhood vaccinations?

By the time children start school they should have had their MMR and 4-in-1 pre-school booster vaccinations. If your child missed having these vaccinations, it's not too late!

Childhood vaccines help to protect your child from many serious and potentially deadly diseases, and help stop diseases spreading to people who cannot have vaccines, such as babies too young to be vaccinated and those who are too ill to be vaccinated.



The MMR vaccine protects against measles, mumps and rubella. The 4-in-1 pre-school booster protects against diphtheria, polio, tetanus and whooping cough.

The MMR vaccine can be given at any age, including to adults, and the 4-in-1 pre-school booster vaccine can be given to anyone up to the age of ten.

Speak to your GP practice to book any missed vaccinations.

From January 2026 children who were born on or after 1 July 2024 will be offered their 2nd MMR dose when they attend for the new 18 month appointment.
