EYFS designed their own pirate pictures onto material, these were then attached to a stick to create flags. The children then acted out pirate stories while walking the plank. A few children took cover from the sun by hiding out in a shelter.



Year 1 linked in their classroom topic of transport into the woodland and crafted small boats. These were built using wooden resources found on the woodland floor to make the boat and a small piece of paper was used to for the sail. This week year 5 took a closer look at plants and put them into categories of ferns, mosses, angiosperms and gymnosperms. We spoke about different conditions plants and creatures need to live and adaptations they make to survive.



Year 6 took great delight in getting one another wet while playing water games this week, although all agreed it was nice to cool off under such hot conditions. We then took a walk to the top woodland where it is much cooler and enjoyed playing on the rope swing.
