

336 Forest School Diary 3rd July 2026

EYFS took part in water play last week enjoying games such as a fun water quiz and getting a good spray down with the hose, this was much needed to keep cool during the heatwave.



Year 1 mixed together woodland potions using herbs such as rosemary, sage and thyme. The children then tried to guess each other's ingredients by using their sense of smell.



Year 2 all joined in with a water fight during their Forest School session which was enjoyed by both the children and grownups. A few of the group decided it wasn't quite enough just having a water fight and proceeded to soak themselves using a watering can. In between water play the children used their Forest School skills to craft small boats.



Year 3 practised different weaving methods this week. Some of the children chose to use V-shaped sticks to weave around while others chose to place screws into wood slices to create a loom. We plan to continue with these next week and look forward to sharing them with you.



This week year 4 created a river flowing through the woodland by connecting guttering and pipes together to get the water flowing. A few of the children also made a small bridge that allowed them to walk from one side of their river to the other.



Year 5 took to the high ropes this week and climbed the Josie tree. In between climbing, the group enjoyed various activities such as whittling and crafting with sticks and leaves.
